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After further discussion, THE CABINET AGREED

- (1) that the Minister for Communications in Tanganyika be informed that the Kenya Government supported his proposal that the Ministerial Communications Committee of the East African Common Services Organisation should decide that all air traffic rights at present exercised by South Africa in East Africa should cease on the day of Kenya's independence;
- (2) that EACSO be requested to continue discussions with Lufthansa and to offer Lufthansa one landing right at Dar-es-Salaam per week passing through Nairobi and/or Entebbe, subject to satisfactory reciprocal rights being obtained;
- (3) that East African Airways be required to submit a report in six months' time showing the effect to itself of the Lufthansa operations;
- (4) that negotiations on other bilaterals be held up until the further negotiations with the Federal German Government have been satisfactorily completed; and
- (5) that the Minister for Works take the necessary action.

32. THE NATIONAL FLAG.

The Cabinet considered memorandum CAB (63) 20 by the Minister for Works and examined ten differing designs of the National Flag.

After discussion, THE CABINET AGREED

- (1) that white strips should separate the major colours, rather than gold;
- (2) that the design and colour of the shield should be considered further by the Minister for Works and the Minister of State, Prime Minister's Office, in conjunction, and that fresh designs of the shield should be prepared and submitted to the informal meeting of Ministers to be held on 2nd July (Minute 35 refers);

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
