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37. CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES.

The Minutes of the Third Meeting held on 26th June, 1963, were confirmed.

38. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES.

(i) The Constitution (Minute 20).

It was AGREED that the question of the status and powers of Regional Authorities and the wider question of the implementation of the new Constitution would be discussed at the routine meeting to be held on 10th July. The Minister of Justice would prepare a paper as the basis of discussion.

(ii) The National Flag (Minute 32).

THE MINISTER FOR WORKS displayed to the Cabinet various designs of shield and, after discussion, it was AGREED that design No. 23 be accepted but that the two oblong white panels on either side of the shield should be black. The Cabinet also ACCEPTED the description of the flag set out in paragraph 5 of memorandum CAB (63) 20.

39. INDEPENDENCE STAMP ISSUE.

The Cabinet had before it memorandum CAB (63) 26 by the Minister for Justice.

Ministers examined the various designs of Independence stamps displayed by Mr. Moore and commented on them as follows:
